- **Property Damage Recovery:** In case of any university property damage caused by a student or group of students, the committee will recover the costs involved through fines, followed by necessary disciplinary actions.
- **Progressive Discipline:** When instances of indiscipline are observed among students, the committee will initially issue warnings. If the misconduct persists, they will apply appropriate disciplinary measures based on the committee's rules and regulations.
