ITEM-1: Observations on the key aspects of NAAC Peer Team Visit

The NAAC has accredited GITAM with A+ grade with a score of 3.53 dated March 28,2017 for a period of five valid till 27 March,2022.

The Vice Chancellor has informed the members about the accreditation achieved by the University and appreciated the efforts of all the stakeholders. He thanked the

NAAC Peer Team members for their tireless effort in the process of accreditation of the University.

Further, the observations provided on the key aspects provided by the members of the Peer Team of NAAC were discussed.

The members expressed their views on the following.

- Implementation of e-Governance: The Vice Chancellor has directed the Director, CATS to chalk a plan of action to make paperless administration from the next Academic Year onwards.
- The Vice Chancellor has directed Registrar to recruit quality faculty by maintaining Teacher Student Ratio with proper cadre Ratio.
- More funds will be allocated towards Library Automation for the coming financial year.

Various other suggestions of the Peer Team will be circulated to concerned Heads of the Institutes\Departments for further follow up action.

ITEM-2: Initiating Academic Audit with revised format

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The Director- IQAC has proposed the Revised Academic Audit Proforma for discussion and feedback for year 2016-17. The Proforma format was approved and appreciated by the members. The Vice Chancellor requested the Director, IQAC to initiate the process by auditing the Departments based on the format and submit the observations.

ITEM-3: ISO Certification accorded to University

The University prepared the ISO Quality Manual and accordingly the Audit was done by the External agency ISO TUV SUD for three campuses and accorded ISO 9001:2015 Certification from 16 February 2016 for a period of three years with Annual Surveillance Audit every year.

The members congratulated the IQAC team for their efforts and requested for regular follow up.

ITEM-4: NIRF Rank to the University

The Vice Chancellor has placed before the committee, a significant achievement of NIRF Rank 89 for the 2017. The University has stood with in the Top 100 in NIRF University Rankings announced by MHRD.

ITEM-5: Discussion on Admission Process

The Director conveyed the members that the GITAM Admission process has started and demand ratio need to improve when compared to previous year where 68,488 applications had received out of which 4,646 have admitted. The members suggested increasing brand-building activity of GITAM for improvement especially engineering and management programmes.

ITEM-6: Any other points

The Director has conveyed the members about the importance of applying for UI Green metric Ranking and requested for approval.

Prof. K. Aruna Lakshmi has suggested to initiate the Research Forum to discuss scientific innovations among the faculties by inviting Experts to build a culture of inter-disciplinary research in University and collaborate activities. The suggestion was welcomed by members and requested to follow it up for implementation.
