ITEM-1: Sanction of Category I status by MHRD

The University has received Category-I status, one of the significant achievement among Deemed to be Universities in the State. It enables the University to start new courses, off campus centers, skill development courses, research parks and any other new academic

programs. It also provide flexibility to hire foreign faculty, enroll foreign students, give incentive based emoluments to the faculty, enter into academic collaborations and run open distance learning programmes.

The members applauded the recognition and this will facilitate the university to grow further.

ITEM-2: Submission of data to THE 2019

The IQAC has placed to the members the data and comparative statement over previous years and is progressive. The members approved the same and requested to submit the data to THE 2019 rankings.

ITEM-3: NIRF Rank to GITAM

The University secured 85th Rank in the third cycle of NIRF under University Overall category. The University has performed well in comparing with earlier cycle which was 89. The members appreciated the achievement of the university. The publication and patents data shared by NIRF for validation has been placed for perusal and suggestions.

ITEM -4: Skill development for Non-Teaching Staff

The Vice Chancellor has informed that the Directorate of Center for Learning and Sustainability has conducted various programmes for Non-Teaching Staff to enhance the IT productivity skills in light technological transformation by the university. The members further suggested to focus more on drafting email communication system and usage of word & excel tools.

ITEM-5: Academic and Administrative Audit

The IQAC has initiated the Academic and Administrative Audit as per the format discussed and approved by the Vice Chancellor and the key observations were deliberated among the members for suggestions/feedback and necessary follow up was recommended for improving the weaknesses observed. One major weakness is lack of Ph.D. faculty in sufficient numbers.

ITEM -6: Result Analysis and Placement Record Statistics

The Director, IQAC has shared the Result Statistics of the Students for the AY 2017-18 and it was observed that results are around 80%. The Placement Statistics of the outgoing students was shared to the members and major recruiters include Amazon, Microsoft, Oracle, TCS, VMWare, Wipro, Deloitte, Accenture, NCR, Maruti Suzuki etc. The average package is around 05 Lakhs per Annum. Highest Salary around 12 Lakhs. The members appreciated the Placement team and Faculty for their efforts in improving the placement record.
