At the outset, the Chairman has extended a warm welcome to all Academic Council members and introduced the external experts and special invitees to the members of the Council.

The Chairman briefed about the significance of National Education Policy and its influence on the Higher Education System in our country.

A brief discussion on how to implement the National Education Policy followed, and it was recommended that further discussion take place at the BoS for various programs.

The meeting then continued with the other items of the circulated agenda.

ITEM-1: Confirmation of the Minutes of the 18^{th} meeting of the Academic Council held on 28-08-2020

The Minutes of the 18th meeting of the Academic Council held on 28-08-2020 are confirmed.

ITEM-2: Action Taken Report on the resolutions of the 18th meeting of the Academic Council held on 28-08-2020

The members noted the Action Taken Report on the resolutions of the 18th meeting of the Academic Council.

ITEM-3: To consider adoption of policies with respect to higher education as per National Education Policy 2020

Higher education must enable an individual to study one or more specialized areas of interest at a deep level, develop character, ethical and constitutional values, intellectual curiosity, scientific temper, creativity, and spirit of service.

After due deliberations, members of the Academic Council have highlighted the following key recommendations in National Educational Policy (NEP) and stated the significance of incorporating the same in the curriculum to enable the student to become a holistic individual.

- 1. Focus on multidisciplinary undergraduate education by revamping curriculum, pedagogy, assessment, and student support for enhanced student experience.
- 2. Increase access to infrastructure and learning materials, online education, and Open Distance Learning (ODL) programmes to disadvantaged and underprivileged students.
- 3. Place equal emphasis on teaching and research, thus enabling the higher education institution (HEI) to become a Research-intensive University.
- 4. Ensure high quality and standards in ODL and online programmes by integrating with the curricula of HEIs to run in blended mode.
- 5. Emphasis is to be placed on creativity, innovation, critical thinking, problem-solving abilities, teamwork, communication skills, social and moral awareness in addition to the opted core programme.
- 6. The curriculum is to be carefully balanced to attain the purpose of multidisciplinary education.
- 7. Examine the possibility of including multiple entry and exit policies in the programmes.
- 8. Revise the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) for instilling innovation and flexibility.
- 9. Prepare a structure for the new assessment procedure to move to a criterion-based grading system that assesses student achievement based on the learning goals for each programme.
- 10. The Council has emphasized the need to create various departments, including Literature, Music, Philosophy, Indology, Art, Dance, Theater, Education, Translation, and Interpretation. A

policy has to be devised for the students to pursue the same through open platforms, including SWAYAM, Coursera, etc., and transfer the credits to the University if the departments are not currently available on any of the campuses.
