







GITAM - Graduation/completion target for of Low Income Category


GITAM sets 100 percent target for the successful completion of the program by the students. Due to some unavoidable circumstances some students could not complete their program. In general, the success rate lies in between 95% - 98%.

There are 100 students under the category Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) in the final year of various programs. 100% graduated in the AY 2023-24

GITAM System of Monitoring and tracking the student progress is explained below with sample screenshots of the system.

GITAM has a well-designed & structured online system called G_SIS (GITAM Student Information System) for student mentoring. Each faculty would be allotted 20 students as mentees. The academic performance and progress of these students are monitored by the mentoring faculty. They will conduct mentor-mentee meetings. The progress and performance of the students would be intimated to the parents also. Steps would be taken to support the weak students who were falling behind.










Mentor - Mentee interaction



































































G-Result Online Module for result analysis
