
SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT

- This project was taken in response to the National Clean and Green Environment Mission, as well as the Swatch Bharat Abhiyan Guidelines.
- Housekeeping personnel collected solid garbage and garden waste from hostel rooms and the campus in separate containers, which were then gathered at the waste yard labelled Compost Pit at the far end of campus.
- Dry garbage, such as paper and plastics, is separated here and transported via vans to recycling centres.
- After processing in a hole constructed for this purpose, the wet waste is recycled along with Cafeteria waste for soil manure/fertilizers.
- We use this manure in our own garden.
