



- GITAM University prioritise the differently-abled students and creates the suitable facilities for their comfort.
- It provides infrastructural needs to enable them to easily access classrooms, laboratories, toilets, etc for barrier free learning environment.
- Persons utilizing mobility devices, such as wheelchairs, crutches, and walkers, as well as those walking with the assistance of others, should be given adequate room.
- Surface parking for two car spaces near the entrance for physically handicapped people with a maximum travel distance of 30 meters from the building entrance are provided.
- Every building has at least one handicapped-accessible entrance, which should be clearly marked.
- In each set of toilets, one unique western closet for the handicapped is provided, with a washbasin at the door.












Services for the Visually Challenged:

1. LIBRARY has a dedicated Section, particularly for visually impaired users. This section has the following facilities:

JAWS (Job Access With Speech) software for Windows (Screen Reading Software - Version 17.0 (3ILM Keys)

(JAWS is the world's most popular *screen reader*, developed for users whose vision loss prevents them from using the computer. JAWS is part of a family of products for blind and low-vision computer users, which includes screen magnification, scanning, and reading, a PDA for the visually challenged, Braille displays, and note-takers.)

- · ZOOM-EX (Camera for Blind & Low Vision)
- · OPTIMA Distance View Glass.
- · Braille Books

2. LIBRARY is a member of the <u>Sugamya Pustakalaya</u>.

The Sugamya Pustakalaya is the aggregator of accessible versions of books available in India. This library is created by **the DAISY Forum of India (DFI)** to provide access to books to persons with print disabilities.

Bookshare, the most extensive International online library for persons with print disabilities, is integrated into Sugamya Pustakalaya. All the titles available in Bookshare Library for India can be searched and downloaded through Sugamya Pustakalaya.

Through this membership, the registered users can avail the following benefits:

i) Download books

ii) Request books offline

iii) Create and view wish lists

iv) Download Books from Bookshare Library for India

v) Place a request for a new book

DFI member organizations get the admin and user-level access to the Daisy India Library. This entitles them to

1. Upload their entire book collection on the DAISY India library

2. Increased outreach: the member organizations can serve print disabled persons all over the country

3. Right to download any book produced anywhere in the country for their students/individual members.

4. Software systems to manage their book distribution or production.
