GITAM being a Category I Deemed to be University and has a National character, practice equal access and promotes Women participation to greater extent. Because of the consistent measures and efficient tracking mechanism, it has ensured the increase in Women Student Applications and the current women student strength in the campus is around 35% Though Merit alone is the criteria for all the schemes, conscious efforts are made by GITAM to ensure the participation of Women Gender in reasonably good proportion. In order to attract women candidates, the entire campus has been provided with high tech Surveillance system, exclusive Women Amenities Centre, exclusive women security staff in the Student hostels etc., The percentage of acceptance of women candidates for higher education is relatively higher (more than 85%).

GITAM has a well-defined admissions policy where the process for admissions for the new academic year, the admissions committee headed by the admissions chairperson periodically conducts review meetings and monitors the application rate, entry rate, withdrawal rate, and counselling for women prospective students by senior women faculty by addressing their queries. GGITAM tracks the women application rate and entry rate under different disciplines. It has MOUs with various organisations who conduct national level entrance examinations and collects the details of the number of students appeared for different national level test who are interested in pursuing a specific discipline. For example, The Common Law Admission Test (CLAT) is a centralized national-level entrance test for admission to under graduate Law programs. National Aptitude Test in Architecture (NATA) is for admission into Architecture program.
